

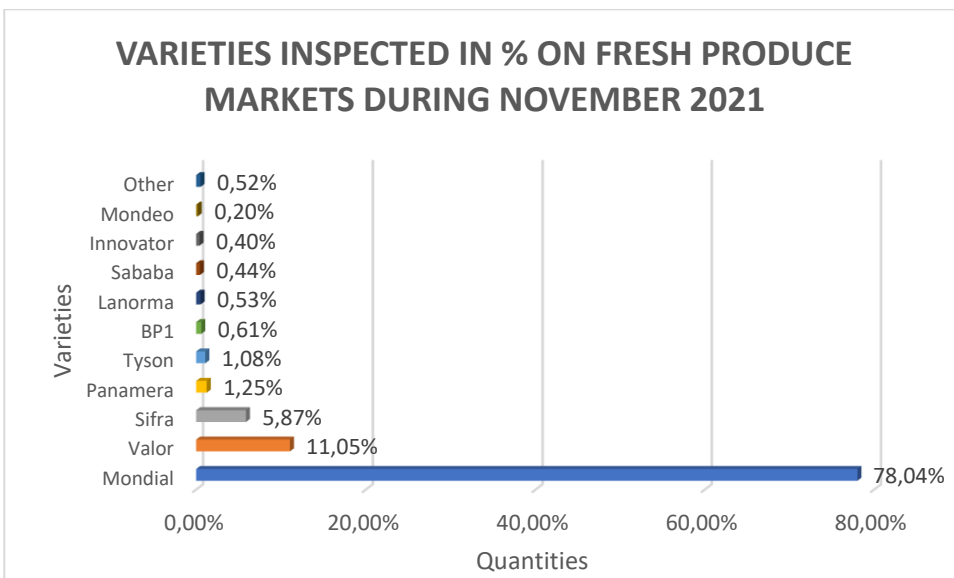
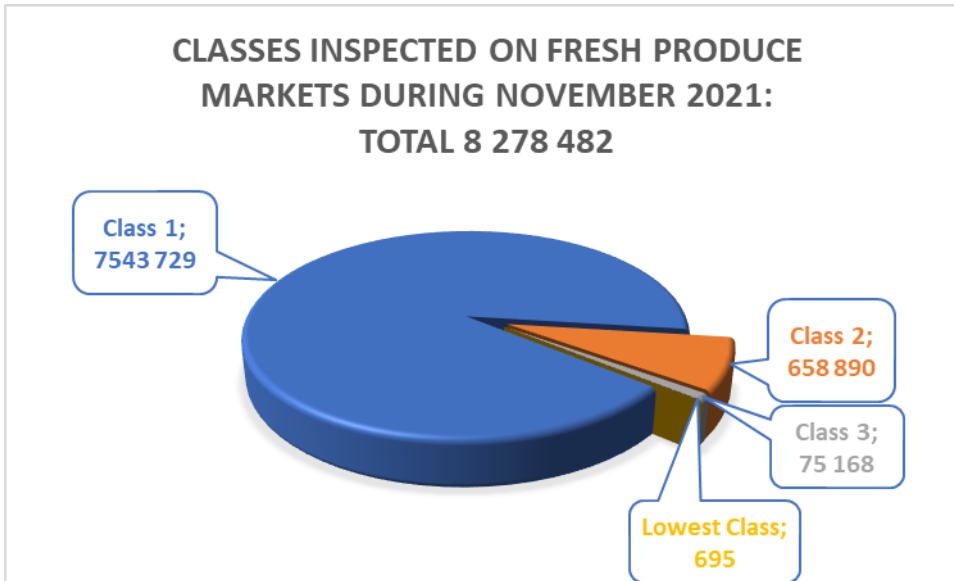


PROKON STATISTICS FOR NOVEMBER 2021

The inspections on potatoes conducted on fresh produce is set out in the schedule below:

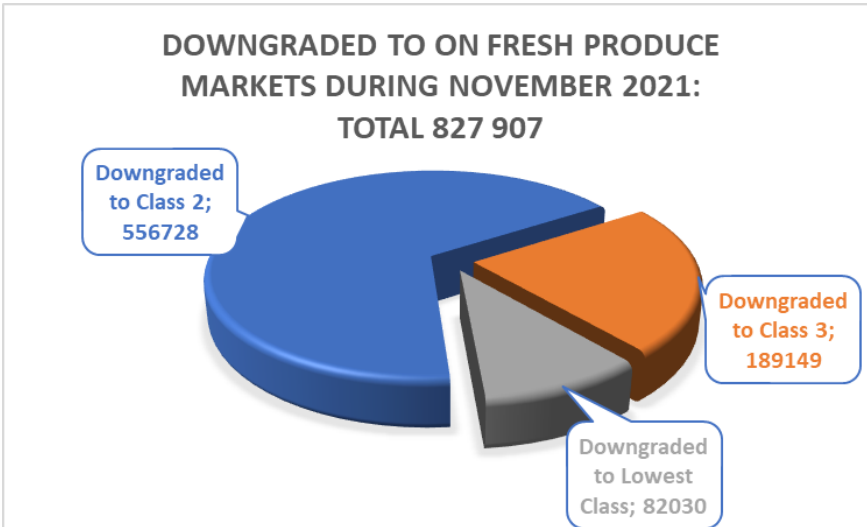
The following data was received for November 2021 from all Fresh Produce markets.

The below two graphs indicates the quantity of classes inspected as well as the main cultivars inspected.

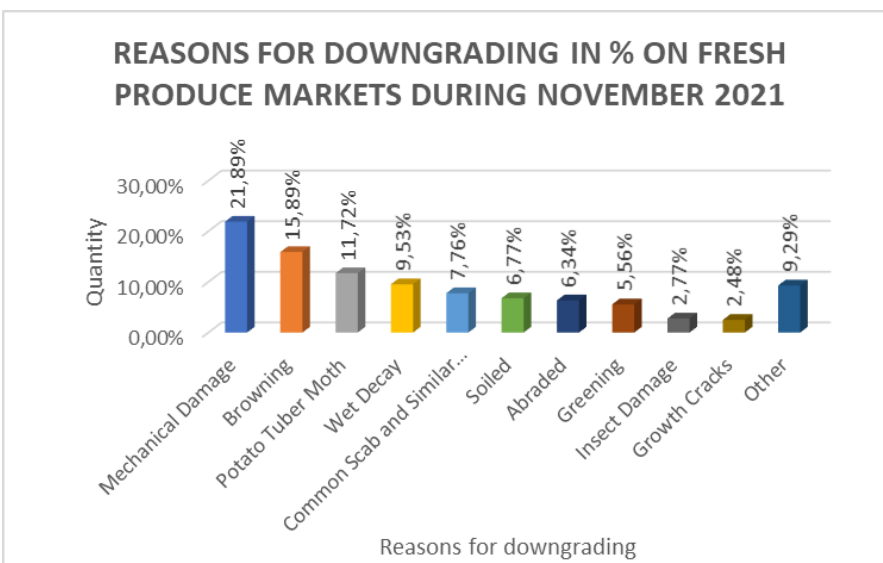
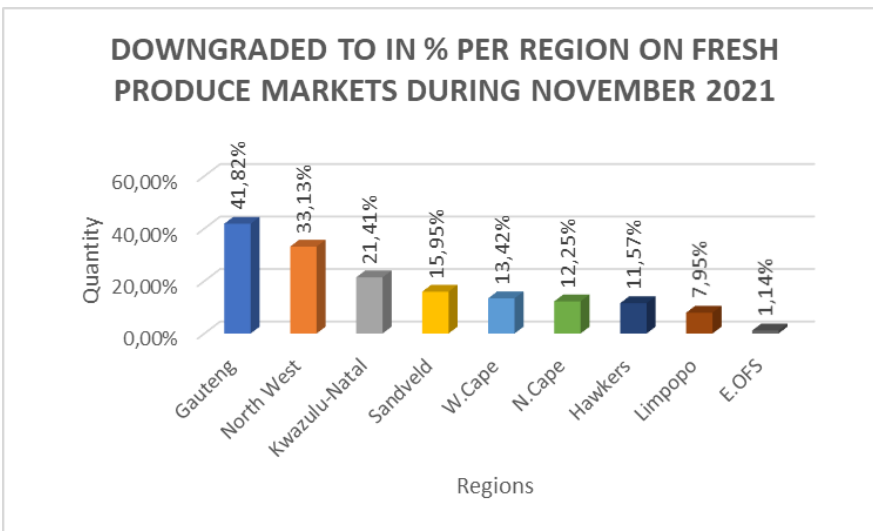


Others include: van der Plank; Sandvelder; Avalanche; Markies; Apache (POWW); Savanna

Others include, broken and cut tubers; cold damage; eelworm; dry stem-end; wilt; brown fleck; malformed; too small; rhizoctonia; heat damage; hollow heart; wet dry decayed tubers; watergrass; vascular browning.
